The following *Terms and Conditions Congress Participants* apply to congress participants of ANGA COM DIGITAL from 8 to 10 June 2021. All persons who register for the online congress (pre-registration and/or onboarding) including employees of partner companies (digital partners) are considered congress participants.

1. Type, purpose and duration of the event

- (1) Type of event: online congress
- (2) The purpose of the event is to initiate and intensify business contacts within the telecommunications and media industry. It is aimed exclusively at companies or industry institutions and their employees. Private individuals or end consumers are not entitled to attend.
- (3) Duration of event: 8 to 10 June 2021

3. Event platform, pre-registration and onboarding

- (1) The subject of the contract is the participation in the online congress ANGA COM DIGITAL by using the digital event platform of ANGA COM DIGITAL.
- (2) Participation in ANGA COM DIGITAL is free of charge for congress participants.
- (3) These *Terms and Conditions Congress Participants* at ANGA COM DIGITAL are bindingly accepted by the congress participant as part of the contract upon registration.
- (4) Congress participants pre-register in advance via online registration with their personal data for participation in ANGA COM DIGITAL. The registration and the contract with the organizer become effective without further confirmation by the organizer upon entry and confirmation of the information by the congress participant.
- (5) Prior to the event, the congress participant will receive a link by e-mail to the registration process (onboarding) on the digital event platform to create his virtual profile for ANGA COM DIGITAL and to fill it with his personal data. The link will be sent to the e-mail address provided in the pre-registration. All data entered can subsequently be adjusted within the personal profile at any time.
- (6) ANGA COM DIGITAL is organized via the digital event platform *talque* of Real Life Interaction GmbH. The pre-registration and onboarding process also is carried out via this platform.

4. Use of the platform by the congress participant

- (1) The congress participant is enabled to participate in the online congress ANGA COM DIGITAL free of charge by being granted access to the digital event

platform. Due to the free of charge registration a legal claim to get access does not exist.

- (2) The congress participant bears sole responsibility for all content posted by him on the platform (in particular profile and interactions, e.g. chat messages, document dispatch and links) not to violate the general laws and rights of third parties. As a matter of principle, the organizer does not control the content that the congress participant posts and publishes via the event platform and does not assume any warranty for this content, neither for its correctness and legality nor for its other condition.
- (3) The contents posted by the congress participant may in particular
 - a. not contain any criminal or disorderly content,
 - b. not glorify, trivialize or incite violence or war and the like,
 - c. not contain any political, discriminatory, racist, extremist or otherwise immoral statements, insinuations or representations, and do not incite such statements, insinuations or representations,
 - d. not be used to express religious or offensive opinions or to incite others to do so,
 - e. not contain any statements, insinuations or representations that are incompatible with basic democratic values and/or the Basic Law of the Federal Republic of Germany
 - f. not include avatars, symbols, signets or logos that contradict the restrictions in letters a. to e. above,
 - g. not lead to a deliberate technical malfunction or misuse of the platform or the software.
- (4) The congress participant also undertakes not to post any content or to advertise any content whose distribution in broadcasting or telemedia is illegal. In particular, he may not post content or advertise content whose dissemination is punishable by law or which is likely to endanger the development of children or adolescents or their upbringing as a responsible and socially competent personality. The same applies to content that the congress participant integrates from external sources, including third party content. If content is labelled as such in accordance with the "Jugenschutzgesetz" (German Youth Protection Act), the congress participant must clearly indicate this.
- (5) Photo, video and audio recordings as well as other recordings of the contents of the event platform by the congress participant is only permitted if there is a legal basis for this or written permission from the organizer.

5. Data usage and visibility of the congress participant

- (1) To achieve the purpose of the contract, the hosting of an online congress to initiate and intensify busi-

ness contacts, the organizer processes personal data of the congress participants and makes them visible to other congress participants and partner companies. The data will be used within the framework of legal regulations and exclusively to achieve the purpose of the event as well as to advertise subsequent events. The consent given with the registration can be withdrawn at any time. In this case, due to the purpose of the contract, the right to participate also ends. For the operation of the digital event platform, the data will also be made available to service companies that process the data on behalf of the organizer and are in turn only authorized to process the data in relation to the purpose of the contract.

- (2) The congress participants register with personal data and further information, e.g. areas of interest. During ANGA COM DIGITAL, the congress participants can use their profile to get in touch with other congress participants and partner companies (digital partners). This takes place via digital networking and matchmaking functions as well as via participation in conference panels.
- (3) All profile data entered by the congress participant is visible to other congress participants and companies on the platform. However, they can be changed at any time in the personal profile.
- (4) Text contributions entered by congress participants in the public chat are visible to other congress participants. The first and last name of the congress participant who publishes the text contribution will also be visible.
- (5) Congress participants who click the "Participate" button when calling up a conference panel or within the conference agenda and who participate in Jump in discussion will be visible to the other panel respectively discussion participants with their first and last names. This enables the participants to network and get in touch with each other.
- (6) Congress participants can individually contact partner companies (digital partners) of ANGA COM DIGITAL via the platform. Depending on the interaction, the partner companies receive contact data of the corresponding congress participant. This personal data includes first name, last name, e-mail address, company name, job title and country, as well as the information in which form the mutual contact was established. Relevant interactions are:
 - Congress participants interact with the partner companies or their employees through chats, calls or meetings. The congress participant's participation in the interaction is voluntary and does not take place without his further involvement.
 - Congress participants press the button "Request more information" within a Digital Showroom of a partner company.
- (7) In addition to the above provisions on data use, the general privacy policy of ANGA Services GmbH shall apply, which is available for inspection on the website www.angacom.de.
- (8) The legal basis for the data processing operations

referred to in these terms and conditions is Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. b) (fulfillment of the contract for participation) and f) (legitimate interest) GDPR.

- (9) Every congress participant has the right to request information, correction, deletion or restricted processing, to object to processing or to assert his right to data portability under the statutory conditions. The organizer is available for corresponding requests at info@angacom.de.

6. Granting of rights by the congress participant

- (1) Within the scope of the purpose of the contract, the congress participant grants the organizer a non-exclusive, worldwide right of use to the content posted by him on the platform insofar as this is necessary for the implementation of the online congress and the functionalities of the technical event platform described in these terms and conditions. The granting of rights includes the right to store, digitize, reproduce, publish and edit the content, insofar as this is done for the purpose of holding the event or advertising subsequent events.

7. Lawful blocking of content

- (1) The organizer reserves the right to review all content on the ANGA COM DIGITAL platform, but without committing itself to do so.
- (2) The organizer is entitled to block or delete from the platform content that violates the specifications stated in these terms and conditions or uses the platform for purposes other than business contact. In the event of serious or sustained violations, the organizer may exclude the congress participant from the event.
- (3) Liability of the organizer towards the congress participant is excluded. This also applies if he must block contents due to legal obligations.

8. Warranty and liability

- (1) Since participation is free of charge, any warranty on the part of the organizer is excluded. This applies to impairments of the usability of the digital event platform. The availability of the platform may be limited in particular due to disruptions, maintenance work or for other reasons.
- (2) The organizer reserves the right to make changes to the conference agenda and to postpone programme items. This also includes the cancellation of individual programme items.
- (3) The liability of the organizer is generally limited to intent and gross negligence.
- (4) Unforeseen events that make it impossible to hold the event as scheduled and for which the organizer is not responsible ("force majeure") entitle the organizer to cancel the event. The organizer may also cancel the event if its economic viability does not appear assured.

9. Place of performance, jurisdiction, applicable law

- (1) Place of performance and jurisdiction is Köln (Cologne) / Germany.
- (2) The Law of the Federal Republic of Germany shall

apply exclusively.

10. Safeguarding clause

- (1) Should individual provisions of these Terms and Conditions be legally invalid or incomplete, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions or the contract. § 139 BGB is not applicable.
- (2) Should individual provisions of this contract be invalid or unenforceable, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. Instead of the invalid or unenforceable provision, the valid and enforceable provision that comes closest to the economic purpose of the invalid or unenforceable provision shall be deemed agreed. The same shall apply in the case of gaps; in this case, the provision shall be deemed to have been agreed which the parties would have reasonably agreed if they had seen the omission.
